Usually one or two interviews



INTERVIEWS

We are looking for

Motivation for course

Ability to think flexibly and critically

Ability to apply knowledge to new problems

Openness to new ideas

We're <u>not</u> looking for

Pre-prepared answers

College choice

Appearance or 'Oxbridge type'

There are no trick questions!



INTERVIEWS: PREPARING

Talk about your subject out loud

Re-read and re-engage with personal statement

Try thinking/working through problems out loud

Arrive ready to engage and discuss







UNIVERSITY SUPPORT



- College-owned accommodation
- Free or subsidised facilities
- Subsidised meals and entertainment
- Bursaries
